



# Inter-Regional RULES 2026

The BFTA is made up of 9 regions. The inter-regional is a competition between the regions. The course will be 40 targets set to **BFTA Main Shoot Rules**. It will be a feed-on start in squads of 9 shooters.

Each region can enter 15 shooters. Only shooters that hold BFTA number from the region can compete for the region.

The best 8 scores will count. In the event of a tie then the best 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 then 15 scores will count. If there is still a tie, then there will be shoot-off between one shooter from each region.

Entry per region is £75.

## Format:

The region will be given 15 cards numbered 1-15; these numbers represent the squad number. It is for the captain to select the shooter for each squad.

At 9am squad 1 will be called. The 9 shooters with 1 on their card should assemble at lane 1. Shooters should pair with someone from another region. This will leave one shooter without a partner; their partner will come from squad 2. This process will continue until all 15 squads have begun shooting.

Can I shoot the event if I'm not in a team?

Usually there are a few spare cards. If spare cards are available, then they are £5 and available from Stats. Spare card shooters must shoot in the squad written on the card.

Spare card shooters scores cannot count in the competition but will be submitted for grading.
